Knot to tie fishing line onto reel

Arbor knot An Arbor Knot is not difficult to learn how to tie to your fishing line. It can be easily used to secure your line to your fishing reels spool on all different types of reels. Whether you are using a bait casting reel, a spinning reel, or a fly reel learning to tie an Arbor Knot is advantageous. The goal of this particular knot is not the belief that your line will steadily hold in the event a fish takes your line down to the very end of your reel spool because this is not going to happen. An Arbor Knot simply gives you something that is strong enough for you to hold onto if your rod and reel go overboard and you need something you can effectively use to pull it up by using your line. The instructions for tying an Arbor Knot are basically simple and easy to follow. You begin the process by wrapping your line around the arbor of your spool.You begin the process by wrapping your line around the arbor of your spool. You must make certain this is done with the tag end of your line. The next step is to tie a very simple overhand knot right around the standing part making certain this includes the tag end. You will then tie your second overhand knot in the tag end and be sure the knot is only an inch or two from the first overhand knot you tied. For the next step you simply pull the standing part of your line so it slides your first overhand knot down all the way to your spool and causes your second knot to jam directly against your first knot.The Uni Knot is also extremely effective when you require something to tie your line in the event you do need to reel it in. One of the positive aspects of a Uni Knot is it only requires one or two wraps instead of the five or six usually necessary to tie onto your hook. Loop the arbor and tie an overhand knot around the main line Take the tag end of the line and make a loop around the arbor of the reel Tie an overhand knot around the main line, leaving enough line to tie another knot Pull the first knot tight Tie a second overhand knot Tie another overhand knot with the tag end Pull the second knot tight Cinch the 2 knots Wet the first knot Pull the line between the first knot and the reel, cinching the two knots together Trim the tag end The tag end knot should cinch up against the first overhand knot, preventing the knots from slipping or untying Trim the tag end Cinch the knots against the arbor Pull the main line to cinch the knots against the arbor You are now ready to spool your reel What is the best knot for tying fishing line to a reel? The center of a fishing reel that has the line spooled around it is called the arbor. The arbor knot is used to tie a fishing line around that arbor. Tying the Arbor knot Arbor knot is used to attach fishing line to the spool of a reel.Tie a overhand knot in the tag end of the fishing line.Tie a second overhand knot around the main line to create a loop with a slip knot.Pass the loop of line over the spool.Pull and tighten the loop down onto the spool.The tag end will stop against the second overhand knot.A little pulling back and forth might be needed to close the loop down tight.Cut off the tag end.Cover the knot with tape to prevent subsequent layers of line catching on it.The Arbor knot is good for monofilament and fluorocarbon lines.Braided line can slip on a smooth spool, wind on a layer of monofilament as backing first.Then attach the braid to the mono backing with a Albright knot. I like to use a little masking tape to cover the knot, especially on a centrepin to prevent line catching on the knot when trotting a float down river. Braided line Braided lines will slip on a smooth spool without a backing. Use the Arbor knot to attach monofilament line to the spool and wind on a layer as backing. Tie the braid to the mono backing with an Albright knot and wind on the braid. Some spinning reels have "braid ready spools" and don't need a backing. These have either a non-slip surface or the braid is attached through a hole in the spool. How to Tie an Arbor Knot Tips The knots made in steps 3 and 5 are known as overhand knots. The second overhand knot prevents the line from slipping through the first one. Variation For increasing friction on highly polished reels, some fishermen wind the line 2-3 times round the arbor before making the first knot. The line should be turned as though tying a tensionless knot, that is, the wraps should tighten on rotating the reel. Simple to tie and effective. Does not slip while winding the fishing line onto the spool. A good choice for fluorocarbon and monofilament lines. Can be used with braided superlines or unfillaments only if the spool is non-slip and braid-ready.
